

Service Line Fees

Prior to the installation of a new natural gas service line, an ERPUD representative will be sent to the location to verify natural gas availability and determine the proposed location for the new service line and meter.

The owner or applicant, having proper authority, will be required to pay applicable tap fees for all new services. Tap Fees include 150 feet of service from the property line to a standard meter location as determined by an ERPUD Representative.

Tap Fee, Residential	No charge
Tap Fee, Small Commercial	\$250.00
Tap Fee, Large Commercial, Industrial	\$500.00 (2" service line) \$700.00 (4" service line)

A service in excess of 150 feet or a service run to a location other than the standard meter location as determined by an ERPUD representative will be billed as excess footage based on the following schedule:

¾" - 1"	service line fee	\$2.00 per linear foot
2"	service line fee	\$4.00 per linear foot
4"	service line fee	\$6.00 per linear foot

Information needed at time of sign up include:

- Complete E911 Address
- Photo Identification
- Payment is requested at time of application.

A service line that has been inactive for a period of five (5) years or more will be treated as a new service line if replacement is necessary.

New services for Federal, State or Local government facilities will not be required to pay a tap fee or service line fee.
